BROOKFIELD LIONS CHARITIES, INC.

BBSA – (LOCAL)– Brookfield Baseball and Softball Association. Donation supports local leagues and provides advertising for Brookfield Lions.

BOOSTER CLUB-(LOCAL). Supports local athletics in the schools.

CHRISTMAS TREE LIGHTING-(LOCAL). Assists with costs of community ceremony.

CAMP HEMLOCKS-(DISTRICT). Provides for special needs of children and adults with learning and/or physical challenges.

NEWS TIMES CAMPERSHIP FUND-(LOCAL). Provides for area disadvantaged youth.

CLERF-(DISTRICT)-Connecticut Lions Eye Research Foundation. Provides funding for eye research projects (i.e. glaucoma, river blindness, low vision, macular degeneration).

CRIS-(LOCAL)-Connecticut Radio Information System. Statewide system of reading for those unable, with local input and involvement.

FIDELCO GUIDE DOGS-(DISTRICT). Training of guide dogs for the vision impaired.

GUIDING EYES FOR THE BLIND-(DISTRICT). Training of guide dogs. Although not district sponsored, provides the same service as FIDELCO.

JUVENILE DIABETES FOUNDATION OF FAIRFIELD COUNTY-(LOCAL). Also a District Lions project, provides funding for juvenile diabetes research.

LCIF-(DISTRICT)-LIONS CLUBS INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION. Charitable arm of Lions, provides assistance to communities in need throughout our world.

LOW VISION CENTER-(LOCAL). Provides reading devices, training, and personal attention to clients who suffer low vision, but are not “legally blind.” District program with local administration (Danbury).

JODI RELL CHARITIES-(UNCATEGORIZED). Share given in return for co-sponsorship of annual golf tournament.

REGIONAL HOSPICE-(LOCAL). Provides assistance to individuals and families dealing with terminal illness.

SPEECH AND HEARING-(DISTRICT). Addresses hearing or speech challenges.

YOUTH OUTREACH-(DISTRICT). Promotes youth activities, including Peace Poster Contest, Youth Camps, Youth Exchange Program, Outreach Program, and Leos Clubs.

FRIENDS OF THE BROOKFIELD LIBRARY-(LOCAL). Supports library materials and programs beyond the provided town budget.

BROOKFIELD SUBSTANCE ABUSE-(LOCAL). Provides forum and program for addressing substance abuse among local youth.

BROOKFIELD HIGH GRADUATION-(LOCAL). Provides raffle prize to be used for senior class graduation party.

I CAN/ANN'S PLACE-(LOCAL). Provides support for cancer survivors.

HOUSATONIC HABITAT FOR HUMANITY-(LOCAL). Provides housing for families in need, with their involvement and contribution.

SHELTER OF THE CROSS-(LOCAL). Provides shelter for older homeless, along with assistance and training for return to self-sufficiency.

CAMPAIGN SIGHT FIRST-(DISTRICT). Provides funding for sight-related issues, i.e. glaucoma research, river blindness.

BROOKFIELD HISTORICAL SOCIETY-(LOCAL). Provides programs and accompanying materials for promotion of local history.

SCHOLARSHIP FUND-(LOCAL). Provides recognition of achievement for graduating students from Brookfield.

PRESIDENT'S DISCRETIONARY FUND-(UNCATEGORIZED). Enables president to support such causes as arise during the year that fall outside the current budget. Items here are brought to the Board and membership as soon as possible.
